1. Tuck Shop and Lunch Box Arrangements

- After a thorough tendering process, Lik Pak Limited has been selected to operate our school's tuck shop and provide lunch boxes starting from December of this year.

- Tuck Shop Service Arrangements:

The tuck shop will officially commence serving students with a wide range of food and drinks from December 1, 2023. The service hours are as follows:

- ✧ Before classes: 7:15 am to 8:25 am
- ✧ First Recess: 10:00 am to 10:20 am
- ✧ Lunchtime: 12:10 pm to 1:10 pm
- ✧ Second Recess: 2:30 pm to 2:40 pm
- ✧ After school: 3:50 pm to 5:00 pm

- Lunch Box Service:

Starting from December 1, 2023, the tuck shop will offer freshly made lunch boxes on-site. The price for lunch boxes in this academic year is HK\$28 each. The ordering details are as follows:

- ✧ Lunch boxes will be sold in the form of meal tickets, and students are required to purchase them on the same day. Monthly subscriptions are not available.
- ✧ Students can pre-order during the morning or the first recess or make purchases on-site during lunchtime.
- ✧ During lunchtime, students need to present the meal tickets of the day at the tuck shop to receive their lunch boxes.
- ✧ Lost meal tickets will not be reissued. In the event of loss, the student must make full payment again to obtain a lunch box.
- ✧ Once the meal ticket has been purchased, students are not permitted to change their selected lunch options.
- ✧ Students with food allergies or special dietary needs should exercise caution when selecting their lunch boxes.

- Bring Own Lunch

To promote a healthy eating culture, the school encourages students to bring their own lunch. The school provides services for students who bring their own lunch to refrigerate and reheat their food.

- From December 1 to December 19, 2023, there will be a transition period. During this period, the current lunch provider, The Glasshouse, will continue to supply pre-ordered lunch boxes. Students will also have the option to bring their own lunch, purchase lunch boxes from the tuck shop, or order for delivery.
- Starting from February 1, 2024, in response to environmental protection and waste reduction, students will no longer be allowed to purchase takeaway lunches. Students in Form 1 to Form 3 must have their lunch at school. Students in Form 4 to Form 6 have the option to have lunch at school or go out, or they can also bring their own lunch. Students are required to bring their own cutlery.

2. School Info Day 2023/24

School Info Day 2023/24 will be organized on Saturday, December 9.

The contents include S1 admission talk, school tours, learning activities of different subjects, STEAM activities. All parents and students, including those who are interested in enrolling in the school, are cordially invited to join the event. Please scan the QR code on the right for registration.
