ARRANGEMENTS FOR FORM 6 STUDENTS RETURNING TO SCHOOL FOR SELF-STUDY

- Starting from 10 March, Form 6 students can return to school for self-study.
- Self-study venue: School Library Opening Hours: 9:00 a.m.– 5:00 p.m.
- Please note the details below:
 - Students must wear school uniform, otherwise they are not allowed to enter the campus. (Students having DSE speaking exam can return to school in casual wear on the exam day. They should show their admission form for identification.)
 - Students should be back after 9:00am. They should also register their arrival and departure time at the general office.
 - Students are not allowed to linger at the corridor or outside the classroom, so as not to interrupt other students in class.
 - Students should follow the school rules when using the study room.
 - Students must take care of their personal belongings.
 - Eating and drinking is only allowed in the designated area of the campus.
 - Using mobile phones is not allowed.

SUMMER UNIFORM AND SEASONAL CHANGE
