
I. Apply for Mainland Travel Permit for Hong Kong and Macao Permanent Residents (Non-Chinese Citizens)

Before making an appointment, non-Chinese Hong Kong permanent residents first need to apply to the Hong Kong Immigration Department for the “Notice of Application for Access to Information”. Specifically, those under the age of 11 who have not yet obtained a Hong Kong identity card need to apply to the Hong Kong Immigration Department for the “Notice of Application for Access to Information” that states their Hong Kong permanent resident status and includes their nationality information.

Notice on Upgrading Visa Application Online Processing System

To further enhance the efficiency of visa applications and optimize service processes, Chinese Visa Application Service Center (Hong Kong) * (hereinafter referred to as the "Our Center") * will implement an online processing system through the Our Center's website. For details, please refer to the official announcement on the website of the Commissioner's Office of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Hong Kong S.A.R. *Notice on Launching the China Online Visa Processing System*.

Starting from **March 17**, all applicants (excluding those applying for visas to Macau, China) must first fill out the application form and submit the required materials online. Only after the online review is approved can proceed to Our Center to submit their documents.

2. The Visa application form will be generated upon the complete of the online procedure, after obtaining the form, the applicant should apply the Visa in person to the Chinese Visa Application Service Centre with all the documents required by the office. Only after the online review is approved, the applicant can proceed to their Centre to submit their documents and further their application procedure.
