### 退團指引 Withdrawal Guidelines

- 本團是獲教育局資助團費。上述費用包括參訪活動、膳食、住宿、交通，以及基本的團體綜合旅遊保險等開支。This tour is funded by the Education Bureau. The fees cover the costs of the visit, meals, residence, transportation, and basic group travel insurance.
- 若出發前有學生要求退出，退出的學生須支付因退團而產生的額外費用，教育局亦可能撤銷對該學生的資助，該學生因而須支付相關團費及額外的退團費用（合共港幣八百四十元正）。If a student requests to withdraw before departure, the withdrawing student must pay any additional fees incurred as a result of the withdrawal. The Education Bureau may also revoke its funding for the student, and as a result, the student must pay the relevant tour fees and additional withdrawal fees(a total of HKD 840).
- 只在特殊情況下，如學生患病（須具醫生證明書）或因其他重要事故而不能如期隨隊出發，教育局才會考慮不撤銷對該學生的資助。Only in special circumstances, such as when a student is ill (with a doctor's certificate) or is unable to depart with the team due to other important accidents, will the Education Bureau consider not revoking the student's funding.
- 註：醫生證明必須由香港註冊之中醫或西醫所簽發之病假紙，而醫生所建議之病假必須包括出發當天；所有到診紙、病歷表、收據均不會獲接納為退團文件，該名同學須繳付相關團費（合共港幣八百四十元正）。Note: The medical certificate must be issued by a registered medicine practitioner or registered Chinese medicine practitioner in Hong Kong and must include the day of departure. All attendance certificates, medical records, medical history forms, and receipts will not be accepted as withdrawal documents. The student must pay the relevant tour fees(a total of HKD 840).

### 注意事項及守則 Rules and Regulations

- 必須聽從隨團老師及旅行社工作人員的指示，不得擅自離隊，嚴守紀律，留心聽講；  
Students must pay attention to and follow the instructions by the teachers and the staffs from the travel agency, they are not allowed to leave the group without permission, and must strictly adhere to discipline.

### 惡劣天氣安排 Bad Weather Arrangement

如遇以下情況，教育局會因應天文台於上午 5 時 30 分至 8 時前發出的相關公布而要求延期出發：

In case of the following situations, the Education Bureau will request a delay in departure based on relevant announcements issued by the Observatory between 5:30 AM and 8:00 AM on the departure day:

- 天文台已發出紅色或黑色暴雨警告信號，教育局宣布學校停課；  
The Observatory has issued a red or black rainstorm warning signal, and the Education Bureau announces the suspension of morning sessions in all schools and full-day schools in Hong Kong.
- 天文台已發出八號預警／八號或以上熱帶氣旋警告信號；  
The Observatory has issued a No. 8 warning / No. 8 or above tropical cyclone warning signal;
- 政府已公布超強颱風後的「極端情況」生效；  
The government has announced the activation of "extreme conditions" following a super typhoon or adverse weather.
